BETACAMP XR INSTRUCTIONS
OVERTE

RIT virtual meeting point is hosted in Overte. Overte is an open source virtual worlds and social VR software which enables you to create and share virtual worlds as virtual reality (VR) and desktop experiences. You can create and host your own virtual world, explore other worlds, meet and connect with other users, attend or host live VR events, and much more. In order to use Overte, you have to follow the next steps.

1- Download Overte from Overte.org, it works only for Linux or Windows. This guide is for Windows users.



2- Once downloaded, click on the .exe file. If you see a warning, click on advanced settings until you see this window. Then click on "Execute anyway" in your own language.


Windows Defender might display a warning about the Windows installer being potentially unsafe. To run it anyway click on "More info" and then "Run anyway".

3- During the installation process, we recommend the "Express Install" version of the installation.



4- Once installed, you can already navigate as an anonymous user, or you can log in, for that you need to create an account in Overte.



5- OPTIONAL: The log in window allows you to create an account or log in.



6- Inside Overte, on your desktop, you can move using W, A, S, D keys. Then the Space bar to fly up and the C key to land and go down. Also, use 1, 2 or 3 to change your Point Of View. In VR mode you can use the left joystick to walk around and the right joystick to turn. You can fly by looking at the sky.

7- For a more VR experience, plug in your headsets with a link cable and Overte will open in VR mode automatically, through SteamVR. Use your hand tracker Y button to open the menu bar.



8- To change your location and reach the BETACAMP meeting place, click on "places" in the menu bar and search for "BetacampRIT".



- **9-** If you would like to change your avatar, you can click on the "Avatar" in the menu bar. You can use the ReadyPlayerMe kiosk under "Overte_hub" to use for your avatar.
- And if you would like to go crazy, search for "Furry_avatars" where you can change to a non-human avatar type.
- **10-** Check your audio settings by clicking on the "Audio" button on the menu bar to choose the mic input or to mute yourself. Also, you can chat through the "Chat" button.
